AERIAL FIRE TRUCK TO BE REFURBISHED

Hancock's Fire Department will be refurbishing its aerial fire truck this October. The city council agreed to the refurbishment and authorized it at its regular meeting on Jan. 4th, 2023. "We had an aerial test done with American Aerial Testing and determined the truck was in really good shape and to have it refurbished," said Hancock Fire Chief Bill Lepisto. It will cost an estimated \$395,000 to complete the repairs while purchasing a brand-new truck would cost around \$1.75 million taxpayer dollars by comparison. Lepisto said Red Power Diesel in Wisconsin will be handling the repairs and the truck would be in repair between 90 and 120 days. The Houghton and Calumet fire departments will be on standby to assist Hancock if needed.
