Cemetery Board of Trustees Special Meeting

Items Discussed:

- This special meeting was called to discuss and determine how the grub problem should be addressed at the cemetery.
- John Silvon, City Council member, told us at the beginning of the meeting that he is planning on attending our July meeting to give a presentation on Green Cemeteries.
- A letter from a community member prompted the debate about how to deal with the problem of grub damage. Discussion of perpetual care lots became a part of the meeting since the grubs are affecting perpetual care and non perpetual care sections.
- It was clarified that perpetual care lots are not only the new lot sections, but there are perpetual care lots in other sections as well.
- Typically no chemicals are used at the cemetery, so Sexton Steve Belo will reseed the affected areas with grass seed.
