

Apply for a Council, Board or Commission

The general process for selecting candidates for appointment to boards and commissions for the City of Hancock is as follows:

- 1. The city posts council, board and commission vacancies on the website, the local newspaper, social media, and the city email list.
- 2. Application material is available:
 - The city's website at <u>https://www.cityofhancock.com/info-</u> <u>committees.php</u>
 - At City Hall, 399 Quincy St, Hancock, MI 49930
 - Email application to the City Clerk, Linda Kalinec at <u>treasurer@cityofhancock.net</u>
- 3. Eligible applicant must complete an application and submit it to the Hancock City Offices.
- 4. Applications are collected by the City Manager by the posted date.
- 5. All applications on file for the Council, board or commission are submitted to the City Council for review.
- 6. The City Council reviews applications submitted for the open position, followed by a nomination and a vote on the appointment.
- Once the individual accepts the appointment a orientation meeting is set up.
- 8. For those individuals not selected, their applications remain on file for one year.
