## DO's

- ✓ Drop off at the Public Works Garage
  - ✓ 1601 Tomasi Dr.
- ✓ Drop off only during Spring Clean-up times
  - ✓ **Friday, May 12<sup>th</sup>**
    - 8:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.
  - ✓ **Saturday, May 13<sup>th</sup>**
    - 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- ✓ Must be a City of Hancock Resident
- ✓ Bring proof of residency such as a driver's license
- ✓ Limit of 4 cubic yards per household or facility.
- ✓ Bring Acceptable items:
  - ✓ Only two box springs or mattresses per household or facility.
  - ✓ Refrigerators
  - ✓ Freezers
  - ✓ washers, dryers
  - ✓ microwaves
  - ✓ Scrap metal including:
    - ✓ Steel
    - ✓ Iron
    - ✓ Copper
    - ✓ Brass
    - ✓ aluminum
    - ✓ bicycles
    - ✓ lawn mowers
    - ✓ snow blowers

## DON'Ts

- Bring **unaccepted** items:
  - **PAINTS**
  - **OILS**
  - **TIRES**
  - **BATTERIES**
  - **E-WASTE (computers, cellphone, etc)**
- No drops off outside of Spring Clean-up times.



### SENIOR CITIZENS AND HANDICAP PICK UP:

If you are a senior citizen (65 years and older) or handicap individual living in a single-family home in the city and unable to deliver your items to the garage, our public works crew will collect your yard debris (all branches must be under 4 feet long) and items accepted in our drop-off dumpsters from your home on specific collection dates. The items for collection must be kept on your own property and are limited to the items listed above.
