The Commission reviewed the November 20, 2015 draft version of the recreation plan, 2016 to 2020, prepared with Commission input by Steve Lasco, a planner with WUPPDR.

The Commission decided to add the old bulldog water tank property, now called the Klondike Park, to the park inventory.

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John Haeussler said he will be submitting some technical corrections, and the Commission discussed Government Lot 5 background and history, and discussed current DNR grant opportunities.

The Commission asked City Manager Anderson to meet with Deb Mann on sites for a new Bocce Ball court.

It was moved by Pekkala and seconded by Slivon to approve the 5 year Recreation Plan 2016 to 2020, and to recommend the plan for approval to the City Council.
